Uniform Expectations

Many students come to school dressed well in a clean and neat manner ready for the day to begin. We often talk to students about ensuring that the little things are in place and done well so that they do not become big things to worry about. We thank the many students who approach each school day with purpose and excellence.

Summer Uniform

- Boys: shorts, shirt, navy socks and Akubra hat
- Girls: skirt, shirt, short navy socks and Panama hat
- The School jumper/vest can be worn when weather is cold

Winter Uniform

- Boys: Long trousers, long sleeved shirt, short navy socks, tie, blazer and winter cap
- Girls: Long trousers/skirt with tights (short navy socks can be worn only when the weather is warmer), long sleeved shirt, tie, long navy socks, blazer and winter cap
- The School jumper/vest can be worn with the winter uniform
- The winter cap and blazer are to be worn to and from school, school excursions and official school events

Sport Uniform

- Students are permitted to wear their sport uniform all day only on days where they have practical PE lessons timetabled.
- The sports uniform consists of the full tracksuit, sports shorts, leggings and t-shirt. As active students, they may at times wear a mixture of winter and summer sports uniform especially on warm winter days and cooler summer days. The expectation for this is that students will present well and of a high standard.
- This is an adjustment from previous expectations.
- Students must have a bucket hat to undertake practical PE lessons.
- The TAS cap is not part of the sports uniform but can be worn outside of school hours and weekends.

Year 12 Students

- Students are permitted to wear their Senior jersey with their sport uniform and on Wednesdays
- During Term Two and Three students are permitted to wear professional business dress on Mondays
 - This change of uniform will not only give the students experience of dressing for a professional/business workplace, but will also help them prepare for interviews, careers and University admission.
 - Examples of appropriate wear are attached for Year 12 families
- General Expectations are:
 - Smart Office/Professional business attire can be worn on Mondays
 - Students have the options to wear formal winter uniform instead
 - No mix of business and school attire (with the exception of the school tie)
 - Gentleman – School tie is to be worn with trousers, long sleeved shirt and jacket
 - Ladies – Trousers/skirt (knee length or below), blouse/shirt, jacket (optional) and small heeled shoe

Hair and Accessories

- No extreme hairstyles are acceptable, such as, tramlines, undercuts, unnatural colours of hair dye and no shorter than a number two clipper
- Boys' hair should be combed and of an acceptable length – above the collar, ears and eyes (if the hair is required to be swept back from the face, or gelled or tied back to be kept off the face, then it is too long and must be cut)
- Girls' hair should be clean, well-kept, off the collar and drawn away from the face – shoulder length hair must be tied back with a navy, gold or maroon ribbon
- Boys must be clean shaven
- Girls may wear silver, gold or pearl studs (5mm diameter maximum) or silver/gold plain sleepers in the lowest hole in the lobe of the ear (if you do decide to allow your child to have additional piercings please ensure that they are removed for school)
- Makeup is not to be worn to school
- No facial jewellery or nail polish is permitted to be worn at school
- Students are not to wear other general jewellery options such as rings, bracelet/ bangle, necklaces etc

If a student has an unacceptable hair style according to the school expectations, they will be told what they need to do to address this. If this requires getting a haircut, or having their hair re-coloured, then the date on which this needs to occur will be negotiated (given that it may take some days to organise a haircut). The Head of Secondary or the Deputy of Secondary will then call the parents to discuss this and will send a follow-up letter to clarify the agreed expectations.

The student is to then have the hair issue addressed by the agreed date. Should the student arrive at school on the agreed date without the issue resolved, then parents will be called and will be asked to pick up their son or daughter from school. The student is not to return to school until the issue is resolved. When they do return, they are to meet with the Head of Secondary or the Deputy of Secondary prior to resuming classes.

We are always encouraging our students to wear the uniform with pride. Unfortunately, some students are not meeting these expectations; therefore, we will be enforcing a revised approach to students who are out of uniform. Students who contravene the uniform expectations will be required to spend break times away from other students, endeavour to make corrections immediately or may be asked to remain home until rectified.
